Statistics

Arrests included: 6 for drug influence and/or possessing drug paraphernalia, 5 for public intoxication, 5 warrant arrests, 5 for shoplifting, 4 for violating probation or parole, 3 for domestic violence, 2 for battery, 1 each for; possessing methamphetamine, child endangerment, embezzlement, resisting arrest, and possessing an illegal weapon. Probation or parole holds were placed on 5 of these arrests.

Officers investigated 2 traffic collisions. Two vehicles were impounded for 30 days due to the drivers being unlicensed or suspended.

Officers took reports of: 5 thefts, 5 missing persons, 2 found property, 2 vandalisms, 2 abandoned vehicles, 2 elder abuse, and 1 each of; suicidal subject, rape, stolen vehicle recovery, counterfeit bill, and child neglect.

Officers assisted the Mendocino Major Crimes Task Force with a narcotics investigation.

Highlights for the Week

On May 26th at about 10:55 AM Ukiah Police responded to Safeway, at 653 South State Street, for a 10 year old girl that had been kicked by an adult male. Officers contacted the 10 year old and her mother, and determined the child was leaving the bathroom when she was confronted by 35 year old Justin Owen Quarterman. Quarterman apparently yelled at the child to move, then chased her briefly and kicked her in the ankle area. Officers located Quarterman a short distance from the store, and arrested him for child endangerment and battery.

On May 30th at about 3:40 PM Ukiah Police responded to Wal Mart, at 1155 Airport Park Boulevard, for a subject causing a disturbance inside the store. Officers were told by store employees that 35 year old Ali Shaun Walker was observed throwing bottles in the parking lot, and was suspected of stealing items after going in and out of the store numerous times. Ali was apparently behaving inappropriately with female store employees, and physically bumping into people in the store. Upon the officer trying to contact Ali inside the store, Ali ran and tried to evade the officer, then physically resisted and had to be restrained to be arrested. Ali was arrested for public intoxication, resisting arrest, and violating parole.

On May 30th at about 5:00 PM Ukiah Police responded to Wal Mart, at 1155 Airport Park Boulevard, for an embezzlement. Officers were told a store employee was suspected of conducting fraudulent transactions and of taking money from the store in excess of \$2000.00. Officers contacted and arrested 22 year old Jewelina Priscilla Acosta for embezzlement.

On May 31st at about 11:20 AM the Mendocino Major Crimes Task Force served a search warrant on a residence in the 100 block of Leslie Street. Inside the residence agents located a scale and numerous empty baggies, commonly associated with the sales of methamphetamine. Also located were over 15 separate baggies of

methamphetamine: ranging from under ½ gram to over 10 grams in weight. Agents also located two shotguns inside the residence. The resident, 49 year old Marilyn Sue Berg, was a convicted felon and prohibited from possessing firearms. Berg was arrested for possessing methamphetamine for sale, being armed in the commission of a felony, and for prohibited possession of firearms.
