On 07/05/2012 at about 9:29 PM, A Ukiah Police Department Officer attempted to conduct a traffic stop on a vehicle, a 1999 blue Pontiac Grand Am, traveling northbound in the 800 block of N. State St. The Driver, **Scott Andrew Faber** (age 33 of Ukiah), attempted to evade the officer and fled in the vehicle he was driving. **Faber** first traveled westbound up Low Gap Rd turning right onto N. Bush St failing to stop for the stop sign posted at this intersection and continued northbound on N Bush St reaching a speed of 45 MPH as he turned eastbound onto Garrett Dr. **Faber** continued to fail to yield to the officer and continued to N. State St, again failing to stop at the posted stop sign as he turned left and continued northbound on N. State St. **Faber** then proceeded to drive in excess of 50 MPH as he drove northbound on N State St. exiting the city limits of Ukiah. The officer continued to pursue **Faber** as he travelled northbound on N State St nearing Calpella reaching speeds of 80 MPH. Once **Faber** entered into Calpella **Faber** turned westbound onto Moore St and then southbound onto Eastside Calpella Rd where he finally stopped. **Faber** was taken into custody without further incident and booked into the Mendocino County Jail for the following charges;

2800.2(a) VC – evading a peace officer; reckless driving

14601.1(a) VC – driving on a suspended license

23152(a) VC driving under the influence

3056 PC – parole violation
