PRESS RELEASE

On December 21st at about 3:50 AM Ukiah Police Officers responded to the apartment complex in the 700 block of Village Circle for two males prowling in the parking lot. One of the responding officers located two subjects in the center of the complex, and both subjects immediately ran southbound upon seeing the officer. Another officer positioned himself at the south end of the complex, and joined in chasing the subjects who changed direction and began running northbound. Both officers chased after the suspects and one of the subjects, 25 year old Ryan Adam Raya, eventually stopped running before reaching the end of the complex and was taken into custody. The second subject was pursued as he headed west into the Yokayo Center, in the 700 block of South State Street, then continued north along Porzio Lane before he was located attempting to hide from officers in the bushes. The subject, 25 year old Armando Hernandez, was arrested for resisting arrest and public intoxication. Hernandez falsely identified himself, but was later found to have a parole warrant for his arrest and charges of providing a false name are being filed with the District Attorney. Raya was wearing clothing commonly associated with criminal street gangs, and was on parole and prohibited from doing so. Raya was charged with resisting arrest and violating parole.
