Statistics

Arrests included: 9 warrant arrests, 7 for being under the influence of a controlled substance and/or possessing drug paraphernalia, 4 for public intoxication, 3 for violating probation or parole, 3 for domestic violence, 2 for shoplifting, 2 for resisting arrest, and 2 for vandalism. Probation or parole holds were placed on 5 of these arrests.

Officers investigated 4 traffic collisions and 1 injury traffic collision. One vehicle was impounded for 30 days for the driver being unlicensed or suspended.

Officers took reports of: 8 thefts, 6 child neglect, 5 abandoned vehicles, 4 vandalisms, 4 burglaries, 3 found property, and 1 each of; identity theft, battery, violating court order, sales of marijuana, animal bite, and suicidal subject.

Highlights for the Week

On March 6th at about 8:55 PM Ukiah Police responded to the 1200 block of Airport Park Boulevard for a disturbance. Officers were then advised of a male subject laying in the roadway in the 1200 block of South State Street, then running east on Hastings Avenue. Officers encountered the subject who was wearing only pants and shoes, and who was highly excited. The subject was found to be intoxicated, and he originally lied about his name but was later identified as 23 year old Corey Dontae Holston, of San Diego. Holston was arrested for public intoxication and for providing false identity and for a warrant from San Diego County for assault with a dangerous weapon. 14-0685

On March 7th at about 5:15 AM Ukiah Police responded to Safeway, at 653 South State Street, for a vandalism. Officers learned store employees had observed 19 year old Darrel Fredrick Pike opening a beer inside the store, and forced him to leave. Pike exited the store and kicked over a flower stand causing damage to the merchandise. Pike was located in the 400 block of South Main Street, and was subsequently placed under citizen's arrest for vandalism. 14-0693

On March 8th at about 9:25 PM Ukiah Police responded to the 700 block of South Dora Street for a disturbance. Officers contacted 28 year old Julio Joel Perez, of Boonville, who was found to have a warrant from Oregon for violating probation related to illegal possession of marijuana, and was arrested. 14-0706

On March 8th at about 9:10 PM a subject, identified as 54 year old Joseph Carl Dalton, came to the Ukiah Police Department at 300 Seminary Avenue. Dalton reported he had been threatened by a subject, and went on to state this subject had threatened him with a pipe. Dalton proceeded to make a lavish and exuberant statement and appeared to be very paranoid, acting bizarre, and exhibited obvious symptoms of drug influence. It was determined Dalton had injected methamphetamine recently, and he was arrested for being under the influence of a controlled substance. 14-0707

On March 10th at about 2:25 AM Ukiah Police stopped a bicyclist in the 800 block of North State Street, and identified him as 48 year old Mark Jeffrey Brandt, of Ukiah. Brandt was on probation and displayed symptoms of recently having used an illegal drug. Brandt was found

to have used methamphetamine recently, and was in possession of a methamphetamine smoking pipe and was arrested. Brandt had a pair of work boots tied together and hanging around his neck, and had several credit cards and identification cards not belonging to him, in his jacket pocket. The officers had earlier handled a suspicious subject call in the 600 block of South State Street, and recognized the photo on one of the ID's as the caller. The officers determined that caller had been a victim of a vehicle burglary several days prior wherein credit cards and identification was stolen. A further search of Brandt's property revealed numerous other credit and gift cards, identification, and miscellaneous electronics and tools to include cell phones, cameras, car keys, and clothing. The Ukiah Police Department has received a very sharp increase in reports of vehicle burglaries recently, most of which include a window of the vehicle being broken out. The Ukiah Police Department is continuing to process the evidence in this case which remains under investigation. 14-0712

On March 10th at about 5:45 PM Ukiah Police responded to the parking lot at Crush, at 1180 Airport Park Boulevard, for a fight. Officers learned 34 year old Kevin Bobby Norton, of Willits, had been in a physical fight with the female victim, and had struck the victim with a crutch and punched her in the side of the head. The victim sustained visible injuries from the assault, but declined medical treatment. Norton, who was very intoxicated, was arrested for domestic violence, and charges of assault with a dangerous weapon are being sought with the District Attorney's Office. 14-0724

On March 11th at about 1:45 AM Ukiah Police observed a vehicle traveling south in the 600 block of South State Street at a very high rate of speed. Officers caught up to the vehicle in the 100 block of Talmage Road and determined the driver, 25 year old Lauren Elizabeth Coates, of Florida, had been drinking. Coates was found too intoxicated to drive and was arrested for DUI. 14-0725

On March 11th at about 4:15 PM a Ukiah Police Sergeant observed 60 year old Greg Henry Steliga in the 900 block of South Dora Street. Steliga had warrant for his arrest for violating probation, and warrant from Sonoma County related to Family Support. Steliga ran from the sergeant briefly, but was captured after a short foot pursuit. Steliga was arrested for the warrants and for resisting arrest. 14-0728
