PRESS RELEASE

On 9/22/14 at about 7:45 PM Ukiah Police department Officers responded to the railroad tracks on E. Gobbi St. regarding a report of a possible sighting of an escapee at large. This escapee was identified as Brett Harlan who had been seen walking S/B along the railroad tracks. Harlan had been given a court ordered pass to visit with his dying mother and was ordered to turn himself back in to the jail by 09/16/14 at 4:00 PM yet he failed to do so.

Upon officers arrival they searched the area for Harlan and found him sitting on the railroad tracks. Harlan was taken into custody without incident. Harlan was transported to the county jail where he was booked back into the jail for violation of 4532 PC – escape by persons in custody on authorized leave.
