PRESS RELEASE

On February 18th at about 2:30 PM Ukiah Police responded to a stabbing at a business in the 700 block of South State Street, wherein the victim was stabbed in the back. The suspect fled the scene and the victim subsequently received treatment at the Ukiah Valley Medical Center. Ukiah Police Detectives responded to assist with the investigation, and obtained a description of the suspect.

On February 19th at about 1:50 PM Ukiah Police Detectives spotted a subject resembling the suspect description in the Wal-Mart parking lot, at 1155 Airport Park Boulevard. Detectives contacted 34 year old Ronald William Feagin of Ukiah. Ukiah Police Detectives determined Feagin was the suspect in the stabbing and arrested Feagin for assault with deadly weapon. Feagin was booked into the Mendocino County Jail.
