The Patrol Division's average response time to in-progress calls was a little under 5 minutes. The average response time to all other calls was a little under 11 minutes.

Highlights for the Week

On October 1st at about 1:39 PM, a UPD Officer was dispatched to Kohl's on a reported shoplifter being detained. Upon arrival the officer contacted a female subject, who was identified as Christian Hoffman age 51 of Ukiah. Hoffman was being detained by store security. During the theft investigation it was determined that

Hoffman had stolen a silver ring that was recovered and that she was on probation out of this county. Hoffman was placed under arrest for shoplifting and violation of her probation. Hoffman was booked into county jail for the violations. 15-2881

On October 2nd at about 7PM, UPD officers were dispatched to a residence on Lorraine Street, for a report of an unknown male subject in the backyard of a vacant residence for sale. Upon arrival and search of the residence, officers located a male subject inside the garage, who was identified as Daniel Stumfels age 42 of Ukiah. Stumfels was found to be wearing latex type gloves and was detained, so officers could begin a residential burglary investigation. During this investigation officers found that Stumfels was in possession of drug paraphernalia and an illegal controlled substance. Stumfels was placed under arrest for burglary, possession of a controlled substance and drug paraphernalia. Stumfels was booked into county jail on the violations. 15-2897

On October 2nd at about 7:21 PM, UPD officers were dispatched to Regal Cinemas Ukiah 6 on South State Street, on a report of a male subject causing a disturbance. Upon arrival officers contacted a subject, who was identified as Justin Timberlake. Upon speaking with Timberlake and attempting to ascertain why he was being disruptive, they found that he appeared extremely intoxicated and was also on probation out of this county. Timberlake was found to be too intoxicated for care for his safety or that of others and was placed under arrest for drunk in public and violation of his probation. He was booked into county jail on the violations. 15-2898

On October 3rd at about 1:21 AM, a UPD officer was on active patrol, in the 200 block of North State Street, when a male subject ran out in the middle of the roadway. The subject was yelling and began touching the officer's patrol car. The officer, who had stopped his patrol vehicle, contacted the subject. The subject was known to the officer as Steven Berry age 32 of Ukiah. Berry displayed the extreme signs of alcohol intoxication and was found to be too intoxicated to care for his safety or that of others. Berry was placed under arrest for drunk in public and booked into county jail. 15-2904

On October 3rd at about 1:53 AM, a UPD officer was on active patrol working traffic enforcement, when he performed a traffic stop on a black Ford Focus in the 100 block of Leslie Street. The officer contacted the driver, who identified himself as Tyler Billy age 24 of Hopland. As the officer spoke with Billy, he noticed that Billy displayed the objective signs of alcohol intoxication, so the officer began a DUI investigation. Billy was found to be too intoxicated to be operating a motor vehicle and was arrested for driving under the influence. Billy also was driving on a suspended license and had an active misdemeanor warrant. Billy was booked into county jail on the violations. The passenger in Billy's vehicle was identified as Anthony Billy age 24 of Hopland. Anthony Billy was found to be too intoxicated to care for his safety or that of others, and was taken into custody for drunk in public. 15-2905

On October 3rd at about 10:39 AM, UPD officers were dispatched to McDonalds on North State Street, for a report of a male subject causing a disturbance. Upon arrival officers contacted Wayne Campbell age 42 of Ukiah, who is on probation. During the subsequent investigation, officers discovered that Campbell had entered the restaurant and appeared extremely agitated. Campbell was yelling, being disruptive inside the business and

refused to leave when asked. At one point Campbell knocked a credit card machine off of the counter. Campbell was placed under arrest for interfering with the normal operations of a business and violation of his probation. Campbell was booked into county jail for the violations. 15-2909

On October 5th at about 8:30 AM, UPD officers went to the Discovery Inn located on North State Street on a report of Dustin Jordan age 36 of Ukiah, staying in a room at the motel. Jordan is on probation out of this county, is on PRCS, and there was a probation pick up order for his arrest. Jordan was located at the motel and taken into custody without incident. After his arrest, Jordan was found to be in possession of drug paraphernalia. Jordan was booked into county jail for violation of his probation and possession of drug paraphernalia. 15-2927

On October 3rd at about 1:15 AM, a UPD Officer was dispatched to the 1100 block of South Dora Street, regarding a theft. The victim reported that he had his backpack stolen from his unlocked vehicle. On October 5th at about 9:34 AM, the victim observed a female subject in the area of South Dora Street, wearing what appeared to be his stolen backpack. UPD was contacted and an officer responded and contacted the female subject. The female subject was identified as Sherri Neeley age 45 of Ukiah, who is on probation. The backpack was identified as belonging to the victim and Neeley was taken into custody. Neeley was also found to be in possession of a switchblade knife. Neeley was booked into county jail for possession of a switchblade knife, possession of stolen property, and violation of probation. 15-2928

On October 7th at about 4:15 AM, UPD officers were dispatched to Alex Thomas Park on a report of a subject inside the park walking around swinging a chain. Upon arrival a male subject was contacted and identified as James Brown age 50 of Ukiah. During the investigation officers found that Brown appeared to be somewhat intoxicated. Also, they found damage to electrical lines and lighting in the park. Through the investigation Brown was linked to vandalizing the parks' electrical and lighting. Brown was placed under arrest for vandalism and being in the park during hours when it is closed. Brown was booked into county jail for the violations. 15-2948
