SUSPECT: UNKNOWN

On 11-6-15 at approx. 4:22 AM, UPD Officers were dispatched to an alarm call at U.S. Cellular located at 1232 Airport Park Blvd. Upon UPD Officers' arrivals, they found one of the glass walls of the building was completely caved inward. UPD Officers searched the inside of the building and did not locate anybody still inside the business.

By accessing store surveillance recordings, it was discovered that an unknown suspect used a rental vehicle to cause the damage to the glass wall and then enter the inside of the business. The unknown suspect was seen stealing numerous items from inside the business and quickly fleeing the scene in the rental van. The rental van was later located after being abandoned in a different location.

U.S. Cellular employees estimated that over \$950 worth of store merchandise was stolen during the burglary. UPD Detectives were notified and have been actively investigating the incident. Anyone with additional information is encouraged to contact UPD at 707-463-6262.
