PRESS RELEASE

UPD Case # 15-3456

On 11-22-15 at approx. 8:30 AM, UPD officers were dispatched to Garton Tractor (285 Talmage Rd.), regarding damage to their locked gate and vehicles stolen from their locked yard. A white 2014 Dodge Ram 3500 pickup, a 1981 car hauler trailer, as well as 2 new Kubota side by side UTVs had been stolen from inside of their yard. Evidence located at the scene indicated that the Dodge Ram had been driven through the South gate. The total loss/damage was estimated to be approx. \$80,000.00. The theft occurred in between 11-21-15 at noon and 11-22-15 at approx. 08:30 AM.

On 11-23-15 at approx. 3:00 PM, information was obtained that the Dodge Ram and car hauler trailer were in the vicinity of Eel River Rd. and the Van Arsdale bridge North of Potter Valley, Ca. UPD detectives subsequently located the Dodge Ram and trailer abandoned in two separate locations in the area of Eel River Rd. and the Van Arsdale bridge.

The two UTV side by sides are still unaccounted for. One is orange in color and the other one is camo. Anyone who has any information regarding this investigation is encouraged to contact UPD at 707-463-6262. A photo of similar UTVs to the ones stolen is attached.
