UPD Case 16-0234

On January 25th at about 9:30 am, a UPD Officer was dispatched to Alliance Auto in the 200 block of South Main Street regarding a stolen vehicle. During the investigation it was determined that on January 24th, just after 6 pm a male subject stole a customer's vehicle from the parking lot of the business. The theft was captured on video and an Officer recognized the suspect as Jeremiah Mcosker, age 37 of Ukiah.

On January 26th at around 9:30 am, a UPD patrol officer on active patrol was on Norgard Lane. The officer observed Mcosker and a second male subject walking to the parked stolen vehicle. Additional UPD Officers arrived to assist, and Mcosker was taken into custody. The male subject with Mcosker was identified as Kalieb Davis, age 20 from Ventura CA. Davis was detained and found to have drug paraphernalia in his possession. Additionally, a records check revealed that Davis had 5 out of county Misdemeanor warrants for arrest. He was taken into custody. Mcosker is on PRCS and his probation Officer was contacted and a PRCS revocation hold was issued. Mcosker was booked into county jail for possession of a stolen vehicle and PRCS violence. Davis was booked into County jail on his warrants and for possession of drug paraphernalia.
