Statistics

Arrests included: 9 warrant arrests, 4 Public intoxication, 2 Domestic Violence, 3 DUI, 2 Shoplifting, 4 Possession of a controlled substance, and one each for Being under the influence and/or possession of drug paraphernalia, possession of stolen property, and prowling. Of these arrests 5 were additionally charged with violation of probation.

Officers investigated and took reports of: 4 Found Property, 5 traffic collisions, 2 death investigations, 3 City code violations, 3 suspected child abuse, 2 vandalism, 3 thefts, 2 vehicle thefts, 2 Burglary, and 1 each of mental Health evaluation, Driving without a license, Sex registrant, 1 theft of firearm, and 1 Domestic dispute. The Patrol Division's average response time to in-progress calls was a little under 3 minutes. The average response time to all other calls was a little under 11 minutes.

The Patrol Division's average response time to in-progress calls was 4 minutes. The average response time to all other calls was a little over 11 minutes.

Highlights for the Week

On 01/28/2016, at about 1044 AM, Ukiah Police conducted a probation search of Charles Maxfield's residence. During this search Maxfield attempted to discard a methamphetamine pipe when officers entered the residence. Maxfield was detained and a search was conducted. During this search Maxfield was found to be in possession of a small amount of suspected heroin and paraphernalia associated with this drug's use. Maxfield was arrested and booked into the Mendocino County jail for violation of probation, possession of a controlled substance and possession of drug paraphernalia. 16-0269

On 01/29/2016 at about 617 PM, Ukiah Police responded to the 700 block of E. Perkins St. to investigate a report of a non-injury traffic collision. Upon arrival, Officers learned that a green Ford escort had collided with a green Dodge truck that had been stopped in traffic due to an unrelated vehicle turning left into Starbucks. When officers contacted the driver of the Escort, Christopher Lopez, they observed objective symptoms of alcohol intoxication. Due to these symptoms and that Lopez had admitted to driving after being involved in a traffic collision, officers had Lopez complete a series of field sobriety tests. Lopez was arrested for DUI. 16-0289

On 1/30/2016 at about 641 PM, Ukiah Police responded to Wal-Mart due to a shoplifter in custody. Upon officers arrival they contacted Wal-Mart's Loss Prevention Officer, who had detained Rodolfo Ceja after observing him attempt to shoplift property belonging to the store. The officer took Cela into custody and searched his person incident to this arrest. During this search the officer located a used syringe in Ceja's jacket pocket. Ceja was found to be on probation out of Mendocino County. Ceja was booked into the Mendocino County jail for shoplifting, violation of probation and possession of drug paraphernalia. 16-0291

On 01/30/2016, at about 1154 PM, Ukiah Police had stopped a white Chevy Silverado in the 900 block of N. State St, due to multiple traffic violations. Upon contact with the driver, Daniel Milligan, the officer observed that Milligan displayed symptoms of alcohol intoxication. The officer had Milligan exit the vehicle and perform a series of field sobriety tests. Milligan was arrested for DUI. 16-0295

On 02/02/2016 at about 105 PM, a Ukiah Police officer observed Rocky Duman in the passenger seat of a vehicle that had passed by the officer. The officer recognized Duman and knew that Duman was wanted on an active felony arrest warrant. The officer stopped the vehicle in the 900 block of S. State St and contacted Duman, who remained seated in the vehicle. Duman was taken into custody without incident. As Duman was being placed under arrest a second officer contacted the driver, Jesse Wolf. Wolf was found to be driving on a suspended license and during a search of his person, Wolf was found to be in possession of stolen property, and in possession of a taser. Both Wolf and Duman were booked into the Mendocino County jail. 16-0314

On 02/03/2016 at about 852 AM, Ukiah Police observed Fernando Fabian in the 200 block of Observatory Ave. Fabian was pushing a motorized scooter matching the description of a recently stolen vehicle. Officers contacted Fabian and learned he was on probation with terms of "submit to search and seizure." A search of Fabian's person was conducted. Fabian was found to be in possession of a controlled substance, paraphernalia, a dagger, and ammunition. The motorized scooter was determined to not match the recently stolen scooter. Fabian was arrested and officers responded to his residence and conducted a search of Fabian's residence. While here officers contacted Martin Cagnina and Kelly Wade inside, who were also on probation with terms of "submit to search and seizure. Both Cagnina and Wade were searched by officers and found each were to be in possession of controlled substance and paraphernalia. All three were arrested and booked into the Mendocino County jail. 16-0323.
