Press Release Burglary UPD case #16-0550

On 2/24/2016, Ukiah Police had investigated a burglary to a storage unit at U-Haul, 1140 N. State St., in which several small antiques were reported stolen. During this investigation video surveillance was obtained and a possible suspect identified. This suspect was identified as 37 year old Ukiah resident, Christopher Daugherty.

On 02/25/2016, at about 5:43 PM, Ukiah Police observed Daugherty riding a bicycle on Waugh Ln. Officers contacted Daugherty, who was carrying a backpack at the time, and arrested him without incident. During a search of Daugherty's backpack officers recovered several items reported stolen from the storage unit on 02/24/2016. Also found on Daugherty's person was a small amount of suspected heroin and a methamphetamine pipe.

Daugherty was booked into the Mendocino County jail for burglary, possession of a controlled substance, possession of drug paraphernalia and violation of his probation.
