Press Release Vehicle Pursuit UPD case #16-0667

On 3/7/16 at about 3:22 pm, a UPD officer on patrol on Betty Street attempted to stop a Silver Honda Sedan for a traffic violation. The driver of the vehicle accelerated away from the officer at a high rate of speed and the officer initiated a vehicle pursuit. The pursuit ended when the driver of the vehicle stopped on North Orchard Avenue, just past Ford Street and fled on foot. The officer gave chase and soon caught up to and appended the driver, who was identified as Esteban Jorge Camarillo age 23 of Ukiah. Camarillo was placed under arrest for felony evading, a warrant for felony violation of probation, and violation of his probation. Additionally, Camarillo was found to be in possession of suspected methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia. Camarillo was booked into county jail for the violations.
