### **Press Release: Foot Pursuit / man arrested**

**UPD case # 16-2807**

On September 27<sup>th</sup> at about 8:09 am, UPD officers were dispatched to area of Oak Manor Drive, for a report of a male subject with baggie clothes possibly carrying a machete, walking from Oak Manor Park. Upon arrival a UPD officer noticed a subject that matched the description in the creek bed that borders the school and park property. The officer recognized the subject as Heath Jarvis age 22. The officer was aware that Jarvis was on summary probation from a prior resisting arrest case. As the officer went to contact Jarvis, he took off running through the creek and the officer gave chase. During the foot-pursuit, Jarvis discarded items he was carrying. Responding officers set up a perimeter as Jarvis ran across Hwy 101 toward the Kings Court area. Officers were able to catch Jarvis in the Kings Court area and took him into custody. Officers located property that Jarvis had discarded during the chase, which was found to be suspected methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia. Officers were unable to locate a machete as reported. Jarvis was booked into county jail for violation of his probation, possession of a controlled substance, possession of drug paraphernalia and resisting / delaying an officer.
