### **Press Release: Two Parolees arrested / handgun seized UPD case # 16-3484**

On December 11<sup>th</sup> at about 8:39 pm, a UPD Patrol Sergeant performed an enforcement stop on vehicle in the 200 block of Ford Street, for traffic violations. Upon contact the UPD Sergeant recognized the driver as Farand Hoaglin age 39 and observed three passengers inside the vehicle. As the officer spoke with Hoaglin regarding the violations, UPD dispatch conducted a records check and found that Hoaglin was on parole and had an active felony warrant for his arrest. Other UPD officers arrived to assist and Hoaglin was taken into custody. Inside the vehicle an officer located a loaded 9mm semi-automatic handgun. Hoaglin was additionally charged with felon in possession of a firearm and felon in possession of ammunition. During the investigation, one of the three passengers initially identified themselves as "Dennis Ocampo", but later was identified as Ricardo Hoaglin age 43. As the UPD Sergeant spoke with Ricardo Hoaglin, he found him to be intoxicated. A records check revealed that Ricardo Hoaglin was also on parole and had a felony warrant for his arrest, as well. Ricardo Hoaglin was taken into custody for falsely impersonating another person, public intoxication and for the felony warrant. Both Farand and Ricardo Hoaglin were booked into county jail.
