Press Release: Hit and Run / fire hydrant damaged Ukiah Police Department case # 17-1149



On April 22nd at about 4:18 pm, UPD officers were dispatched to the 400 block of Park Blvd., regarding a hit and run traffic collision. Upon arrival, officers located a white 2001 Mercedes coupe that had collided with a City of Ukiah fire hydrant. The Mercedes had been abandoned by the driver and had sustained major damage. The water main to the fire hydrant was broken, causing damage to the road and flooding in a nearby residence. City of Ukiah Public Works responded and was able to shut the water off. UPD officers are investigating the hit and run traffic collision. If anyone has information regarding this incident, please contact the Ukiah Police Department at 463-6262.
