VICTIM: CHASE BANK

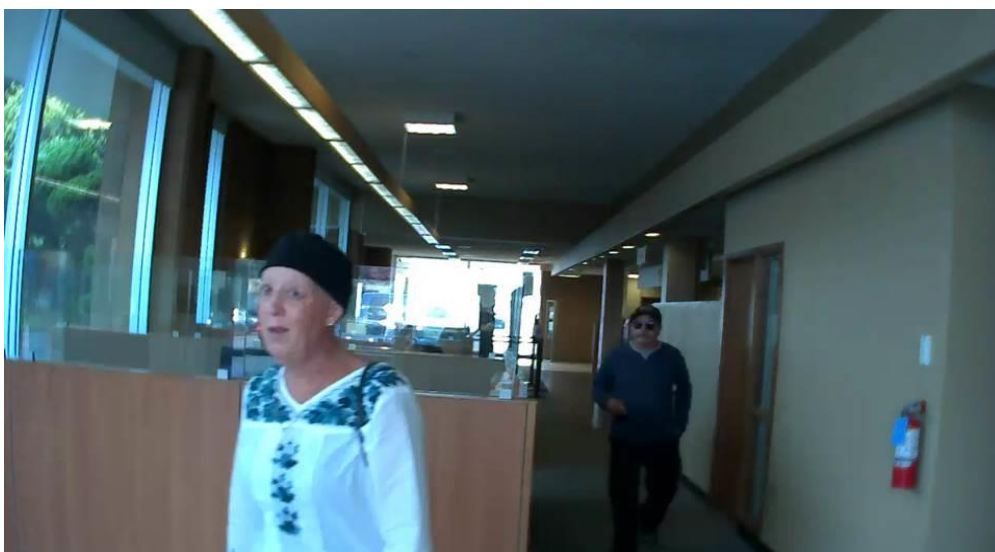
On 8-7-18 at approx. 1619 hours, UPD officers were dispatched to Chase Bank (700 S. State St.) regarding a bank robbery. Officers learned that a white male had displayed a threatening note to a teller and robbed the bank. The suspect left the area on foot with an undisclosed amount of cash. No weapon was seen during the robbery. The suspect was described as a white male wearing a dark blue beanie, black sweatshirt with a "3" on the front of it, a dark colored jacket, khaki pants, and black and white shoes. The suspect also wore large sunglasses and had multiple band-aids partially covering his face. Officers are also interested in locating and identifying a female witness who was in the bank at the time of the robbery. Photographs of the male bank robber and female witness are attached.
