




Daily Average Response Times (mm:ss)




The Patrol Division's response time to in-progress calls was just over 3 minutes.

The average response time to all calls was just over 10 minutes.


CRIME BREAKDOWN





UPD CASE #18-1982

On 8-7-18 at approx. 1619 hours, UPD officers were dispatched to Chase Bank (700 S. State St.) regarding a bank robbery. Officers learned that a white male had displayed a threatening note to a teller and robbed the bank.

The suspect left the area on foot with an undisclosed amount of cash. No weapon was seen during the robbery. The suspect was described as a white male wearing a dark blue beanie, black sweatshirt with a "3" on the front of it, a dark colored jacket, khaki pants, and black and white shoes. The suspect also wore large sunglasses and had multiple band aids partially covering his face.

Officers are also interested in locating and identifying a female witness who was in the bank at the time of the robbery. Photographs of the male bank robber and female witness are attached. UPD officers are continuing their investigation.
