SUSPECT: 20 YEAR OLD WHITE MALE-TRANSIENT

On 12-12-18 at approx. 7:18 PM, UPD officers were dispatched to Subway (130 N. Orchard Ave.) regarding shots fired at the location. Upon arrival, an officer located a subject with gunshot wounds in front of Ross. The officer provided first aid until paramedics arrived. The subject was flown to an out of county hospital for medical treatment. It was quickly reported that the injured subject had just robbed the Subway store with a firearm. During the robbery, a customer with a valid concealed carry weapons permit, discharged his firearm reportedly in fear of his safety and the safety of other citizens. The customer also was one of the reporting parties to the robbery. The investigation is on-going.
