On 02/03/19, at approx. 2:00 PM, an unknown male suspect entered Rite Aid, 680 S. State St., wearing dark clothing, sunglasses and a mask similar to a dust mask or medical mask. The suspect approached the pharmacy counter and passed a demand note to the employee. The suspect demanded narcotics and claimed to be armed. The suspect received an undisclosed amount of narcotics and fled the store on foot. Officers responded to the scene and checked the area, but were unable to locate the suspect. Further investigations were conducted by the Ukiah Police Department Detective Division.

The suspect was described as a male, having tan skin, being under 6 foot tall and having dark hair. No one was injured in the event and the investigation is ongoing. Anyone with additional information is urged to contact the Ukiah Police Dept. at 707-463-6262.
