On 02/08/19, at approximately 4:55 PM, UPD officers responded to a residence in the 600 block of Marshall St., regarding a residential burglary. Officers contacted the victim who reported forced entry had been made into his residence and several items were taken from within. The items taken were valued at several thousand dollars.

Video surveillance of the burglary was viewed by the officers and as a result one of the suspects was positively identified as Lawrence Texeira, by Law Enforcement Officers. The vehicle used in the burglary was identified and the owner of the vehicle, Renee Crane was also identified as having participated in the burglary.

On 02/09/19, Texeira was located by Mendocino County Sheriff's Office Deputies on the Mendocino coast. Ukiah Police Officers and a Detective responded to the location and contacted Texeira. While on scene, Crane and her vehicle were located as well. Crane and passenger Aron Hernandez were contacted in the vehicle. During the contact, items from the burglary were observed in the possession of Crane and Hernandez.

A Ukiah Police Detective secured a search warrant for Texeria's residence and vehicle as well as Crane's vehicle and a residence in which Crane and Hernandez lived. Subsequently more items were located which linked the involved parties to the burglary. Crane, Hernandez and Texeira were all taken into custody and transported to the Mendocino County Jail.
