SUSPECT: 14 year old Ukiah High School Student

On 08/22/19, at approx. 1037 hours, Ukiah High School (UHS) officials viewed what was believed to be a drug transaction deal occurring on campus, during school hours. UHS officials began an investigation along with UPD school Resource Officer B. Chapman. Through their investigation it was determined that a 14 year old student was in possession of several prescription pills, concentrated cannabis, two vape pens and other controlled substances. The pills were found to be packaged in a manner consistent with sales. Based on the findings the juvenile was subsequently arrested for the above listed charges and booked into the juvenile hall. After being booked into the juvenile hall, the arrested juvenile was found to be in possession of additional narcotics. The juvenile was additionally charged with 4573(a) PC.

Ukiah Police Detectives and members from the Mendocino Major Crimes Task Force were contacted to assist in the investigation. Search warrants were obtained for the residence of the juvenile. A search of the residence revealed a marijuana Honey Oil Lab being used in the residence. Additional prescription narcotics as well as evidence further substantiating sales of prescription narcotics were located inside the residence. As a result of the search warrants, an 18 year old male adult was arrested at the residence and booked into the Mendocino county jail for the following charges:

11375(b)(1) H&S-Possession of prescription narcotics for sale- Felony  
273a(a) PC-Child Endangerment- Felony  
272(a) PC-Contributing to the delinquency of a minor- Misdemeanor  
182(a)(1) PC-Conspiracy to commit a crime- Felony
