On 8-28-19 at approx. 11 AM, a UPD officer was on routine patrol at the intersection of S. Dora St. and W. Mill St. The officer observed a Mercedes SUV that was recently reported stolen out of Lake County travelling E/B on Mill St. UPD officers conducted a felony high-risk traffic stop on the vehicle in the 100 block of Barbara St. The driver, Mark Nielsen, and passenger, Lindsay Molinero, were both detained and subsequently arrested. Both Nielsen and Molinero were on felony probation out of Lake Co. Nielsen was in possession of a controlled substance.

Nielsen and Molinero were transported to the county jail. Nielsen was lodged for 496(d)(a) PC, 1203.2(a) PC and 11377(a) HS. Molinero was lodged for 496(d)(a) PC and 1203.2(a) PC.
