CITY OF UKIAH ELECTRIC CUSTOMERS WILL NOT BE AFFECTED BY POTENTIAL PSPS EVENT AT THIS TIME

Ukiah, CA. October 8, 2019. – At this time, PG&E has indicated that the City of Ukiah electric system will not be affected by the current PG&E initiated PSPS event. However, this is an extreme weather event impacting multiple regions which could cause instability in power transmission and result in outages. As such, residents should prepare for outages.

Due to mapping limitations, PG&E's PSPS maps show a general area of power outages that overlap into City limits, but as stated above, City of Ukiah electric customers are not anticipated to be affected by the current PSPS event. If you are unsure whether or not you are a City of Ukiah electric customer, you can verify this information by checking your electric utility bill. It is anticipated that some areas immediately outside of the City limits and throughout the inland and unincorporated county will be impacted by this event.

The City of Ukiah is monitoring this event and will provide updates as we receive them.
