## CITY OF UKIAH Notice of Public Hearing General Plan Amendment to Incorporate Senate Bill 244 Disadvantaged Unincorporated Communities Analysis

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a General Plan Amendment is proposed to the City of Ukiah's 1995 General Plan Land Use Element, in accordance with Senate Bill 244 (SB 244). SB 244 requires a city or county, on or before the next adoption of its housing element, to review and update the land use element of its general plan to include an analysis of the presence of island, fringe, or legacy unincorporated communities within or adjacent to its sphere of influence.

The General Plan Amendment includes informational text related to the SB 244 analysis that will be incorporated into the City's General Plan Land Use Element as background information, in accordance with SB 244. It does not propose infrastructure projects or improvements, nor does it propose amendments to the Land Use Map or land use policies.

**PROJECT LOCATION:** The SB 244 analysis includes lands within the City of Ukiah limits in its entirety, as well as the City's Sphere of Influence.

**PROJECT IMPACTS:** The proposed General Plan Amendment text is consistent with the City's 1995 General Plan and meets the exemption criteria outlined in California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15183, Projects Consistent with a Community Plan or Zoning and Section 15061, Review for Exemption.
