RIVERSIDE PARK CLOSED DECEMBER 13TH THROUGH DECEMBER 21ST DUE TO CONSTRUCTION OF RECYCLED WATER PROJECT

Ukiah, CA. December 13, 2018. – Due to construction of the recycled water project, Riverside Park will be closed between December 13th and December 21st during construction hours of 7:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays. During those dates and times, there will be no public access and no parking in the park area; however, all residents will have access to their driveways during construction.

The recycled water project is designed to deliver treated water from the Waste Water Treatment Plant to approximately 650 acres of agriculture, 20 acres of pasture, and 15 acres of turf (including three parks and a school). The project includes a new 66 million gallon reservoir, 38,000 feet of distribution pipe, a 3,500 gallons-per-minute pumping station, and an expanded chlorine contact basin.
