The Feldenkrais Method was developed by Moshe Feldenkrais, a physicist, engineer, martial artist and educator. His method teaches you to become aware of habitual patterns and allows you to find options for new, more efficient and graceful movement. Many aches and pains disappear as we use ourselves in new effortless ways.

In Awareness Through Movement (ATM) lessons, the Feldenkrais teacher verbally guides you through a sequence of movements, usually lying on a pad, but sometimes sitting or standing. The instructions are to move slowly and gently so that self-awareness can begin to expand.

Layperson CPR Training 2020 Standards

To best serve the Ukiah community, these classes will be offered at the same time on the same day depending on individual needs. This will require cooperation from other students to serve all students in a timely and efficient manner. Each class begins with *Before Giving Care* (2 hours) then will be followed by the training segment of highest demand and so on. A timeline will be set up so the students can best plan their training time.

These classes instruct how to respond to emergencies by providing CPR, using an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) and how to deal with First Aid incidents such as shock, bleeding, cuts, bone and muscle injuries, bruises, and other emergencies.

June 9th - Diggin Ditt ft. Soulevily West Coast Funk and Soul

From behind the redwood curtain of Humboldt County, California, the seven piece funk-soul band Diggin Dirt has carved out a niche as a live party not to be missed. Shoveling their own path, Diggin Dirt has seen sustained growth over the past few years, with multiple national tours and festival stops at Jam Cruise, High Sierra, Same Same but Different, Live Oak, Cascade Equinox, Joshua Tree Music Festival and many more.



Per a 2024 Jam Cruise writer, "This was the soul music I grew up with in the '60s and '70s, but I confess I wasn't expecting [Diggin Dirt] to be throwing it down this hard. This group is impossibly tight, and Zach Alder might be the best soul shouter I've ever heard, and I've heard a few."

Their infectious sound is fueled by blazing horns, searing guitars and a relentlessly driving rhythm section, and tying it all together is the band's frontman who launches the ensemble into rarefied air with his pipes, charisma and natural-born soul. With flashes of James Brown or Sly and the Family Stone, Otis Redding or Tower of Power, the band's sound is both familiar and yet refreshingly original, layering psychedelic rock, Motown soul, afrobeat and even reggae atop a thick foundation of late-60s inspired funk.

June 30th - Chris Cain Blue Cuffar Master

Chris Cain offers up a soulful stew of Memphis style electric blues. His powerfully deep vocals and jazz inspired, blues guitar riffs are unforgettable; uniquely his own, while reminiscent of the legendary BB King and Albert King. As a child, Chris Cain attended concerts with his dad to hear many of the great blues artists of the time. When Cain burst onto the blues scene in 1987 with his award winning debut album, he soon found himself sharing the stage and trading licks with a few of those legends, including Albert King and Albert Collins. Chris Cain has released a dozen albums, each filled with soul-stirring songs pulled from his own blues drenched heart. His brand of blues is unforgettable.



Cain was raised on stories of his father's childhood upbringing on Memphis' Historic Beale Street and attended his first B.B King concert at the tender age of three. Blues music played continuously on the home stereo and family outings were often trips to concerts. Cain recalls, "I remember when I was a kid, my Dad would be mowing the lawn with the stereo blasting Muddy Waters. When I look back, that was pretty cool! There was always music playing at our house, Ray Charles, B.B. King, Freddie King, Albert King, all the greats."

At the age of eight, Cain taught himself to play guitar and began playing professionally before he was eighteen. Chris studied music at San Jose City College, and was soon teaching jazz improvisation on campus. The Real Sarahs & Alex De Grassi with Julian Julian

Locals Night Spotlight

As rising stars in the west coast Americana scene, The Real Sarahs have distinguished themselves as skillful harmony singers and evocative songwriters. With an organic sound that enchants and uplifts the spirit, they share their special gift of vocal synergy. This ensemble creates magic with voices in harmony, acoustic instruments, and the energetic connection between artists and audience. Embracing many genres of music, you are likely to hear threads of folk, jazz, blues, bluegrass, and country running through their songs. Singing from the



stories of their own journeys and life experiences, their original music is honest, captivating and heartfelt.

Introduced by a mutual friend in 2010, Sarah 'Songbird' Larkin and Sarah Ryan have been nearly inseparable, musically, since. Their recorded works are diverse and represent the broad musical influences and potential that this duo embodies. The 2017 release Afternoon With the Dirty Birds has the support of full instrumentation and showcases their songs with a big, 'full band' sound. Their 2018 release Headed For The Hills sinks back to their roots as acoustic musicians. This album was recorded in one day, on one microphone, and captures the authentic, raw power of their sound.

With gratitude for the gift of music given them, The Real Sarahs offer back their gifts with open hearts and truth of purpose. These women seek to inspire, uplift and entertain their audiences with songs that speak to the heart of the human experience. With the onset of regional and international touring in 2018, you can expect their voices to ripple out, touching more hearts and minds and carrying their message and influence to an ever broadening field of music lovers. With warmth and humor The Real Sarahs offer their REAL selves to the world as the women of song that they were born to be.

Alex de Grassi has been a unique voice in the world of acoustic guitar for the past 42 years; his innovative approach to composing and arranging for solo steel-string guitar has influenced a generation of younger players. From his first solo performances in university coffeehouses and as a street musician to his engagements at prestigious venues including Carnegie Hall, the Kennedy Center, and the Montreux Jazz Festival, Alex has followed his own vision and helped lay the foundation for contemporary fingerstyle guitar. Inspired by American and British Isles folk and blues artists in his early teens, Alex's musical pursuits soon expanded to encompass classical, jazz, and world music. He has since become known for his evocative compositions and arrangements, and for his sheer virtuosity. Using a broad palette of techniques and timbre in conjunction with his ability to weave together melody, counter-melody, bass, harmony, and rhythm into a highly orchestrated canvas of sound, Alex's performances take the listener well beyond the instrument. The Wall Street Journal has called his playing "flawless" and Billboard hails his "intricate finger-picking technique with an uncanny gift for melodic invention."

JULY 23th - My Kel ROSC Jameier Regges Legend

For over 25 years, MyKal Rose has been recording and performing his brand of militant, hardcore

Jamaican music to the delight of reggae fans around the world. As a solo artist, with Black Uhuru, and back as a solo artist, the "Ruff" Rose has achieved great success throughout his career, even as different Jamaican musical styles have phased in and out of popularity.

Perhaps the highest profile recognition came in 1984, when MyKal Rose and the other Black Uhuru members (Duckie Simpson,



Puma Jones, Sly Dunbar, and Robbie Shakespeare) won reggae's first Grammy award for the album, Anthem. But the story doesn't begin with Black Uhuru. In 1976, MyKal Rose was already a seasoned performer, having honed his skills by performing on Jamaica's hotel circuit.

AUSUST 2217 - Blitzen Trapper Alternative County & India Jam

Blitzen Trapper is a Portland, Oregon-based experimental country/folk/rock band associated with Sub Pop Records, Vagrant Records, Lojinx, and Yep Roc. Formed in 2000, the band currently operates as a quartet, with Eric Earley (guitar/harmonica/vocals/keyboard), Brian Adrian Koch (drums/vocals/harmonica), Michael Elson (bass/keyboard), and Nathan Vanderpool (guitar/vocals); at some shows, Michael Blake fills in for Vanderpool. Blitzen Trapper self-released its first three albums. "Wild Mountain Nation" was No. 98 on Rolling Stone's list of the 100 Best Songs of 2007.

Blitzen Trapper released its third album, Wild Mountain Nation, in 2007 to much acclaim from critics such as Pitchfork Media, The Nerve, and Spin Magazine. The group signed to Sub Pop Records in the summer of 2007.

After the release of Furr in 2008, the group received a two-page feature in Rolling Stone. The album was ranked No. 13 on Rolling Stone's Best Albums of 2008 while the title track was ranked No. 4 on the magazine's Best Singles of 2008. The albums Destroyer of the Void and American Goldwing followed, to similarly high acclaim.

On October 1, 2013, the band released VII, their first on Vagrant Records in the U.S.; the album also appeared on British indie label Lojinx in Europe on September 30. In mid-December 2014, the band self-published their first live album, Live In Portland, followed by the Record Store Day exclusive, a live cover album of Neil Young's Harvest record titled Live Harvest. Their eighth studio album, All Across This Land, was released on October 2, 2015. Their ninth studio release - marking a return to the band's own label LidKerCow - is titled Wild and Reckless and was released on November 3, 2017.

At the end of 2019, longtime members Erik Menteer (guitar/keyboard), Michael Van Pelt (bass), and Marty Marquis (guitar/keyboards/vocals/melodica) retired from the band. Remaining founding members Earley and Koch returned to touring in 2022 with a new lineup. During their hiatus from live shows, the band signed to Yep Roc for the release of their tenth album Holy Smokes Future Jokes on September 25, 2020.

August 18th - Mustache Harbor Yochi Rock Forever

For over a decade MUSTACHE HARBOR has been thrilling audiences across the country with their spot-on renditions of the smoothest music from the 1970's and 80's, all performed with the highest level of musicianship and state-of-the-art sound and lighting. Mustache Harbor is a San Francisco-based soft rock tribute band that plays music from the 1970s and 1980s. The band's mission is to create a mustache



army and "Soft Rock Explosion" like Christopher Cross, Steely Dan, Ace, Kenny Loggins, and The Little River Band. Mustache Harbor's shows are known for being unstoppable, with sold-out shows at Slim's and Bimbo's 365 Club, and standing ovations at Outside Lands Festival and Sausalito Art Festival.







PLEASE NOTE: There will be a \$25 charge for all checks returned from your bank for non-sufficient funds. To make sure your registration is not delayed, please be certain that your forms are complete, correct and signed. Payment, either of cash, check, or money order. If paying by credit card, please visit **ukiah.recdesk.com** to register.

Once you've chosen the programs, complete the registration form and select a payment method. You can Mail-In, Walk-In or, if paying by credit card, go Online at **ukiah.recdesk.com**. If the class of your choice is full, you will be placed on a waiting list and contacted about the status of your registration.

Classes may be cancelled due to lack of enrollment. Please make every effort to pre-register so a class will not be cancelled unnecessarily.
