### **City of Ukiah, California**

#### **Initial Study and Negative Declaration (IS/ND) Ukiah Climate Action Plan**

The City of Ukiah (City) is releasing a Draft Initial Study and Negative Declaration (IS/ND) on the City's Climate Action Plan (CAP). A copy of the IS/ND can be viewed and/or downloaded at <http://www.cityofukiah.com/ceqa-review/> This IS/ND has been prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The City is the lead agency under CEQA.

**Plan Location, Purpose, and Description:** The CAP applies to all areas and plans/projects within the City of Ukiah limits. The purpose of the CAP is to address communitywide greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and the impacts of climate change. The City is committed to an emissions reduction target of 40 percent below 1990 levels by 2030. This 2030 GHG emissions goal is selected to be consistent with SB 32 State emissions targets and the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines for a qualified GHG emissions reduction strategy, and to be achievable by City-supported measures and actions identified in the CAP. To achieve that target, the City has developed the CAP, which includes 15 GHG reduction measures related to building energy, transportation, solid waste, water and wastewater, and carbon sequestration.

**Significant Environmental Impacts:** No potentially significant environmental effects were identified in the Draft IS/ND and no mitigation measures are required.

**Public Review Period:** The Draft IS/MND is being circulated for a 30-day review period, starting from **February 27 through March 28, 2025**. Persons responding are urged to submit their comments in writing. Written comments need to be delivered to the City, at the address listed below or by e-mail, by **no later than 5 p.m. on March 28, 2025**. This document will be available for a 30-day public review period, during which written comments may be submitted to the following address:
