

#### **Feldenkrais**

The Feldenkrais Method was developed by Moshe Feldenkrais, a physicist, engineer, martial artist and educator. His method teaches you to become aware of habitual patterns and allows you to find options for new, more efficient and graceful movement. Many aches and pains disappear as we use ourselves in new effortless ways.

In Awareness Through Movement (ATM) lessons, the Feldenkrais teacher verbally guides you through a sequence of movements, usually lying on a pad, but sometimes sitting or standing. The instructions are to move slowly and gently so that self-awareness can begin to expand.

#### **Layperson CPR Training 2020 Standards**

To best serve the Ukiah community, these classes will be offered at the same time on the same day depending on individual needs. This will require cooperation from other students to serve all students in a timely and efficient manner. Each class begins with *Before Giving Care* (2 hours) then will be followed by the training segment of highest demand and so on. A timeline will be set up so the students can best plan their training time.

These classes instruct how to respond to emergencies by providing CPR, using an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) and how to deal with First Aid incidents such as shock, bleeding, cuts, bone and muscle injuries, bruises, and other emergencies.



The Expendables have proven anything but in their nearly 25-year career since starting out as a spirited party band in high school covering surf-rock nuggets such as Dick Dale's "Miserloo" and "Wipe Out" for birthdays and family gatherings. A quarter-century later, elementary school buddies Raul Bianchi, Adam Peterson and Geoff Weers, along with bassist Ryan DeMars, who joined in 2000, have forged a unique original sound born in the laid-back beach life of their Santa Cruz, CA.

The Expendables' infectious hybrid of ska, surf-rock, punk, reggae and metal can be heard in their latest streaming track, "Surfman Cometh," a spaghetti-western meets "Pipeline" twang that could easily form the soundtrack to the latest Quentin Tarantino film. The song is the first release from the group's new and improved Band Room, their longtime rehearsal space in a 1,100 square foot warehouse and former wine cellar on Coral Street, where Adam Patterson took charge of the mix to great effect. The band is currently touring and working on their next full length album.

Joining The Expendables is Top Shelf, Northern California's premier reggae band, delivering high-energy performances and smooth rhythms that set the perfect mood for a night of celebration.



At a time when most people feel constantly distracted by technology and barraged by the news, authenticity and straightforward honesty are paramount. There's something about the music of The Po' Ramblin' Boys that cuts right through the noise of the world and speaks plainly to the soul. Formed ten years ago in the Smoky Mountains in 2014, The Po' Ramblin' Boys are at once exactly what you would expect and not at all what you would expect from a tattooed East Tennessee Bluegrass outfit. But they take pride in being ambassadors of their genre, and the group has brought their music from rural bluegrass festival stages to the rock clubs of Europe, with stunning results.



Big Mountain originated in 1986 as the reggae band Rainbow Warriors in San Diego. In 1988, Joaquin Quino McWhinney, inspired by Bob Marley and of Mexican/Irish descent, became lead singer of Shiloh, which later became Big Mountain in 1991. The band gained popularity with «Touch My Light» in 1993 and achieved mainstream success with their cover of «Baby, I Love Your Way,» which became a major hit worldwide. Over the years, Big Mountain underwent several lineup changes and appeared at major reggae festivals. After a hiatus starting in 2005, the band reformed in 2013 with a new lineup and released the album Perfect Summer in 2016.

Estrella is a dynamic singer/songwriter blending reggae, jazz, and R&B. Based in Salinas, CA. Her musical journey flourished on Oahu, inspired by love and self-empowerment. She has performed with Tenelle, Pato Banton, Pacific Roots,

The Rudians, and more.



Together for over 32 years, Big Bad Voodoo Daddy — famously named after an autograph by blues legend Albert Collins — has appeared in concert venues across the world, sold millions of records, and had their music appear in hundreds of movies and television shows. With sold out concerts from the Hollywood Bowl to Lincoln Center, appearances with many of the country's finest symphony orchestras, and television appearances ranging from Dancing with the Stars to Superbowl XXXIII, Big Bad Voodoo Daddy continues its decades long mission to celebrate and revitalize jazz and swing music — America's original musical art form — and bring joy to audiences around the world.

# **How Do I Register?**

Choose the programs you want. Complete the registration form fully with all class dates and times listed. Please be sure to sign your form. Please total all fees and include your check or money order payable to the City of Ukiah.

**PLEASE NOTE:** There will be a \$25 charge for all checks returned from your bank for non-sufficient funds. To make sure your registration is not delayed, please be certain that your forms are complete, correct and signed. Payment, either of cash, check, or money order. If paying by credit card, please visit **ukiah.recdesk.com** to register.

Once you've chosen the programs, complete the registration form and select a payment method. You can Mail-In, Walk-In or, if paying by credit card, go Online at **ukiah.recdesk.com**. If the class of your choice is full, you will be placed on a waiting list and contacted about the status of your registration.

Classes may be cancelled due to lack of enrollment. Please make every effort to pre-register so a class will not be cancelled unnecessarily.

#### REFUND POLICY

Refunds are granted only if a written request is received by the City of Ukiah before the second class meeting. There is a 15% administration fee deducted from all refunds. Instructors do not issue credit or refunds for classes you miss. A credit is offered if the class is canceled due to instructor's cancellation.

You will remain on the waiting list until the class begins. We will make every effort to create additional classes and contact you if we have been able to do so.
