BACKGROUND

In celebration of the 150th Anniversary of the incorporation of the City of Ukiah, we are proud to present a special Sesquicentennial Art Exhibition honoring 150 years of community, culture, and growth.

This commemorative exhibition invites artists of all ages and backgrounds to reflect on Ukiah's rich history, vibrant present, and inspiring future. Artwork may capture local landscapes, historic moments, cultural traditions, community life, or imaginative visions of what lies ahead.

The exhibition will serve as a creative tribute to the people, places, and stories that have shaped Ukiah over the past century and a half. Through art, we celebrate our shared legacy and the spirit that continues to move our community forward.

ELIGIBILITY

The call is open to all professional artists and artist teams who meet the following criteria:

- Open to all ages (artists under 18 must apply with parent or guardian permission)
- Artists who currently reside in, work in, attend school in, or were raised in the Ukiah community.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENT

- All applicants will need to submit a completed application to maranda@cityofukiah.com. Photos of work may be included in the document or separately.
- All work must be original to the artist. 2D works preferred including, but not limited to drawings, paintings, photographs, quilts, mixed-media works. Limited space available for 3D art.

SELECTION PROCESS AND TIMELINE

Exhibition Opens – June 12th

EXHIBIT INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS

- Artwork must be framed, properly wired, and ready for installation.
- Artwork must no more than 20 pounds.
- Maximum dimensions per piece: Width: 60-inch (some flexibility for soft goods), Height: 84-inch, and Depth: 6-inch

_____ **Delivery & Pick-Up** I will deliver my artwork on one of the following dates: May 26, 27, 28, 29, June 1, or June 2 to the Ukiah Valley Conference Center, 200 S. School St., Ukiah, CA 95482. I will also be responsible for picking up my artwork after the exhibition concludes on November 22, 23, 24, or 25. The exact delivery and pick-up date must be arranged in advance between the artist and the City of Ukiah.

_____ **Display Conditions & Liability** Artwork will be displayed inside the conference center and may be subject to changes in temperature, relative humidity, and light levels. There is no dedicated surveillance or security monitoring the artwork. The City of Ukiah does not provide insurance coverage for exhibited artwork. I understand and accept these risks and agree that the City of Ukiah is not responsible for theft, loss, or damage to my artwork.

_____ **Hanging & Framing Requirements** City of Ukiah staff will hang the artwork using Command Strips or similar hanging systems. All artwork must be properly framed (when applicable) and securely wired with a hanging wire on the back, ready for installation. Measurements provided in the call for art refer to framed dimensions.

_____ **Use of Images for Promotion** The City of Ukiah may photograph and use images of my artwork for promotional purposes, including social media, print materials, Website and other marketing related to the exhibition and the 150th Anniversary celebrations.

_____ **Sales & Artwork Removal** If you would like your work listed for sale, you must include the relevant information in your submission. Purchased artwork must remain on display until the exhibition ends and must be picked up during the designated removal dates.

_____ I understand that the City of Ukiah is not responsible for theft, damage, or loss of artwork at any time during the exhibition.
