Choose the programs you want. Complete the registration form fully with all class dates and times listed. Please be sure to sign your form. Please total all fees and include your check or money order payable to the City of Ukiah.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be a \$25 charge for all checks returned from your bank for non-sufficient funds. To make sure your registration is not delayed, please be certain that your forms are complete, correct and signed. Payment, either of cash, check, or money order. If paying by credit card, please visit ukiah.recdesk.com to register.

Once you've chosen the programs, complete the registration form and select a payment method. You can Mail-In, Walk-In or, if paying by credit card, go Online at ukiah.recdesk.com. If the class of your choice is full, you will be placed on a waiting list and contacted about the status of your registration.

Classes may be cancelled due to lack of enrollment. Please make every effort to pre-register so a class will not be cancelled unnecessarily.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds are granted only if a written request is received by the City of Ukiah before the second class meeting. There is a 15% administration fee deducted from all refunds. Instructors do not issue credit or refunds for classes you miss. A credit is offered if the class is canceled due to instructor's cancellation.
